- **Roundtable ADC report** – on-line youth protection – everyone is having trouble getting it done – Tony Garcia & Jerry Wilson to send out e-mail suggesting watching video and taking test at roundtable – roster will be kept and training cards given out – possible October roundtable. We are having some trouble recording service hours on double knot. We will start collecting a record of service hours by unit at each roundtable and then turn them in one at a time – include Eagle Projects. POC: Tony Garcia
