The nominating committee is openly seeking interested parties to fill the crucial roles of Vice-Chairs for the 2006-2007 District Committee and one lucky applicant to be the District Chair. We'd love for anyone interested in being involved on some level of the District Committee or Roundtable for 2006-2007, even if you are on it already, to let us know your wishes.

From the District Chairman:

District positions are appointed for one calendar year. In effect, all persons presently serving in any District position are not guaranteed they will serve the next year! Having said that, certainly some of our great volunteers continue to serve in the same or several positions year after year, and that is a great thing for our District. However, we all understand that "new blood" as well as "old blood" must be mixed in order for Kia Kima to thrive and continue to grow strong through the years.

We earnestly implore you – VOLUNTEER! NOMINATE! Recommend Scouters you believe will be a committed asset to our District. There are only three requirements for District service:

- The Scouter must be currently registered in our District
- The Scouter must be at least 21 years of age
- The Scouter must be committed to serve the full year (or longer)

On the reverse of this form you will find our District Structure Chart. ALL positions are open for nomination. (*Except District Executive!*)

The nominating process in Occoneechee Council actually begins in July, and culminates with our District Annual Business meeting in October, each year. This is a very important step in our District's Annual Plan.

During July, August, and September, the Nominating Committee will accept and entertain ANY and ALL nominations for ANY and ALL District positions. All persons nominated will be considered and possibly interviewed and asked to accept a position for the upcoming year.

The persons accepted and appointed serve in their position beginning in January, and through December of the next year. They are appointed and sworn in to their position in October; they work with the current year's appointee, to learn and understand their job position, from the business meeting until 31 December. This ensures a smoother transition and prevents a loss of continuity in that service or functional area.
